

SUMMARY REPORT OF STUDENT SATISFACTORY SURVEY

IQAC, Udalguri college initiated the process of conducting Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) to access the level of satisfaction of the students with an aim to identify the areas with scope of improvement. A structured form was designed and students were instructed to give responses. The survey covered 192 randomly selected students from various departments. After examining the responses, the following information has been obtained -

Findings

1. Out of the total 192 students, 51% of students reported that 75 to 100% of the syllabus was covered in the class off-line as well as online).
2. 62% of the total sample of students were extremely satisfied with their teachers as far as their preparation for the class is concerned.
3. Out of the sampled students, 65.1 % of the students conveyed that they got encouragement from their teachers to participate in extra-curricular activities.
4. Out of the total sampled students 34.09 % of the students felt that teachers have been able to communicate well with the students.
5. 40.6 % of the sampled students conveyed that the institute/teachers use students centric methods for teaching, such as participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.
6. 35.4% of the sampled students felt that the health and hygienic aspects of the institute was excellent.
7. 61.5 % of the sampled students agreed that teachers were highly accessible.
8. 42.2 % of the sampled students felt that the over-all academic environment of the institution was excellent.
9. The sampled students were asked to provide additional feedbacks on areas that need improvement. Majority of the students demanded supply of increasing facility of pure drinking water.

On the basis of the ratings given by the randomly selected students for various parameters, the level of satisfaction can be considered as satisfactory.

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
