#### ANNUAL REPORT OF THE WOMEN CELL UDALGURI COLLEGE UDALGURI

(Period of June 2021 to May 2022)

The Women Cell of Udalguri College, Udalguri which is committed for the aim with which it was established i.e. to empower women in all walks of life both within and outside the campus area, carried out the following works during the session 2021-22 which is described as follows:

#### June 2021 to August 2021:

Two meetings of the Women Cell of the College were organised during this period. The first meeting was held on the 4th of June 2021 at 01:45 PM at the Conference room of Udalguri College. The meeting which was presided over by Dr J. Goswami, was attended by 15 participants from within the teaching and non-teaching staff. As per resolution No-1 of the meeting, the Women Cell thanked Mrs Punu Kalita and Mrs Dipanjali Medhi, both Assistant Professors of the Department of Assamese for having made the Cell proud by carrying extension class activities in Goraibari LP School, Udalguri. The meeting was apprised of the selection of Miss Bibari Boro, Assistant Professor of the Department of Political Science for Ph.D programme in Bodoland University wherein the congregation congratulated her and expressed that more of such endeavours should come from the Women faculty members for higher educational empowerment.



#### June 2022 to August 2022:

The first meeting of this quarter was held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of June 2022 and was presided over by the Convenor of the Cell, Dr J. Goswami. #### March 2024 to May 2024:


